Object of order:	Purchase of 1 (one) raschel net machine RACOP 8F with 8 guide bars, or equivalent. Technical parameters: - Number of guide bars: 8 (6 ground bars and 2 selvedge bars) - Working width: 432 cm - Asynchronous main drive - Central machine control via an integrated programmable logic controller (PLC) - Display: 10.4” touchscreen - Polish language interface - Number of levels of knitting elements: 7 (seven). - Number of beam shafts: 6 (six). - Beam shaft diameter: 152 mm - “Multi-speed” function - Central fabric/net wind-up system, maximum fabric/net roll diameter: 700 mm
Proposal assessment criteria:	The best proposal will be selected based on the following criterion: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Net price - 100% weight, <p>For the sake of calculation it is assumed that 1% of the weight of the criterion = 1 point.</p> <p>The Ordering Party will select the best object of order by granting points for meeting the net price criterion. An offer/proposal shall be deemed the best when it receives the highest number of points, whereby the principles for granting points are as follows:</p> <p>The “net price” criterion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The proposal with the lowest price receives 100 points. ▪ The remaining proposals will receive points in a linear way (with accuracy of two decimal places) in accordance with the following arithmetic formula: $(X+Y) \times 100$, whereby: X = the lowest price quoted, Y = the price of the proposal concerned in the calculation.
Proposal drafting requirements:	As a minimum, the submitted proposal shall contain the following information: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Name, NIP number (Taxpayer’s Identification Number) and address of the Offering Party or the Offering Party’s official business stamp. ▪ Date of proposal issuance, ▪ A description of parameters of the proposed object, with reference to the required parameters listed in the Request for Proposals. ▪ Unit price (net and gross) of the entire object quoted in PLN or in EUR. If the Offering Party chooses to submit their proposal in EUR, the amount in EUR must be converted to PLN in accordance with the

If the conversion from EUR into PLN is not provided in the Proposal, the calculation shall be effected by the Ordering Party.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Indication of the applicable guarantee period. ▪ Validity period of the Proposal. <p>It is also recommended that the Proposal contain other additional information e.g. terms of payment and delivery, possible discounts, maximum delivery period, detailed price breakdown, etc.</p> <p>The required language version of the proposal is Polish, bilingual or English.</p>
